

Membership Classification - Lifetime Member. Any member who has given continuous exemplary service to the Society for not less than 10 years may be recommended by the Membership Committee for Lifetime Membership. The National Executive Board shall have the discretion to approve any such recommendation by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of the members of the full National Executive Board. A Lifetime Member shall not be required to pay dues. A Lifetime Member must pay member assessments at social functions, but is not required to attend the necessary meetings. A Lifetime Member must still comply with the requirement of the Full Member Agreements set forth in Section 5.C. above. Based upon a recommendation of the Membership Committee, the National Executive Board has the discretion to terminate any such Lifetime Membership if such member's occupation or lifestyle becomes adverse to the National Society.
